Membership Info

 All players are required to purchase a membership by <u>Clicking Here</u> or the Court Reserve App. With your Seasonal Membership (\$75), you are allowed to make reservations 7 days in advance. Daily Memberships (\$7), Weekly Memberships (\$25) are NOT able to make morning reservations, however, they are able to play if one of our seasonal members does not show up for their morning block or if we do not fill the morning block.

How Do I Reserve a slot in a morning Time Block?

- 38 players allowed per time slot
- 8:00am 9:30am Session: Three (3) Intermediate Courts, Three (3) Advanced Courts
- 9:30am 11:00am, 11:00am 12:30pm Sessions: One (1) Novice Court, Three (3) Intermediate Courts, and Two (2) Advanced Courts
- On the website go to "Morning Sessions"
- On the app go to "Events"

Reservations will have to be made online (You may only book one time block per day.)

From 12:30pm – 8pm – Open Play with Paddle Rotation (No Reservations necessary)

Rules and Regulations

Margate City Pickleball reserves the right to suspend and or revoke membership privileges. Members must follow the following guidelines:

- Promote a positive membership (Don't bring a bad attitude onto the courts)
- Respect the registration process. (Cancel by 7am if unable to attend court time reservation). Third missed reservation will result in a one-week suspension of reservation privileges.
- Follow all posted rules
- Honor and respect the organization of open play for all players, all ages in all skill groups (Simply put, don't show up to play with your friends in a separate "Grouping" when the courts are full).
- Act kind and respectful to all with your Voice, Words, and Body Language
- Always, and with Courtesy, "Share the Courts"

8am to 12:30pm Session Rules

- A queue will be established for the order of play. A paddle holder is to be used for a paddle player rotation system. *The paddle will be organized from left to right.*
- If you are waiting to get onto a court, place your paddle in the rotation queue. Players will be invited onto open courts in paddle order. Please do not move anyone else's paddle!
- Proper start of play will be four (4) players on. Game ends when one (1) side has eleven (11) points win by two (2) winners stay. Losers rotate off (maximum two (2) games are played for any player then rotate off.

12:30pm to 8pm Rules

- Proper start of play will be four (4) players on. Game ends when one (1) side has eleven (11) points win by two (2) winners stay. Losers rotate off (maximum two (2) games are played for any player then rotate off. (Two (2), Two (2) off).
- When nine (9) paddles are waiting, then rotation will begin as four (4) on court and four (4) off court. (Maximum one (1) game).
- Below nine (9) paddles, then standard play of two (2) on and two (2) off. (Maximum two (2) games per player).

Please follow all court rules and regulations listed on signs at courts.

Outdoor Courts may not be rented hourly

To play on outdoor courts in the morning, you must reserve a spot in our time blocks. (8-9:30, 9:30-11, or 11-12:30) (38 spots total)

-If you are 10 minutes late for your block reservation, someone will replace you.

Weather Policy

- If it rains, Pickleball Courts WILL NOT reopen until they are completely dry! (Check the Margate Community Education and Recreation Department Facebook page for updates)
- If your session is rained out, it will be canceled for that day.
