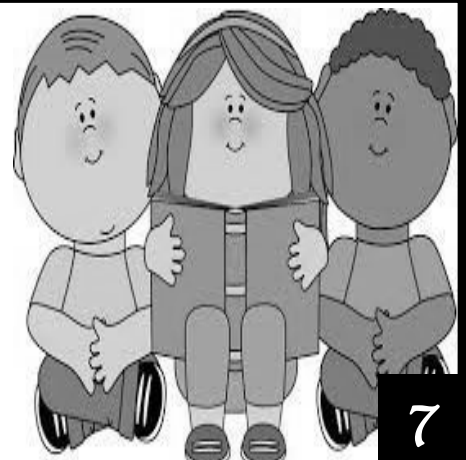

### A Message From The City Regarding Margate City Flood Facts

Flooding in our city is caused by the ocean and bay waters during hurricanes and northeasterly storms; flooding can come with little warning and cause extensive damage. The first thing you should do is check your flood hazard information list. You can call 609-822-1974 or visit the Margate Flood Protection Information page at <https://www.margate-nj.com/flood-protection-information/pages/drainage-system-maintenance>, where you can find city flood maps, elevation certificates. In addition, flood maps and flood protection references are available at the Margate City Public Library. Upon request, our Certified Floodplain Manager (CFM) will visit a property to review its flood problem and explain ways to stop flooding and prevent damage. The CFM can also explain base flood elevation for the area in which your house is located. If you don't have flood insurance, talk to your insurance agent. Homeowner's insurance policies do not cover damage from floods. However, because Margate City participates in the National Flood Insurance Program, you can purchase a separate flood insurance policy and receive a 25% reduction in your premium.
